



BCIS SAT Testing Center will be closed on August 28, 2021

Dear Students Taking the SAT at BCIS,

Due to the pandemic of COVID19 in Bangkok is still very severe in August, 2021. Therefore, BCIS SAT Testing Center **will be closed on August 28, 2021**; however, we will arrange the SAT **make-up test on September 25, 2021**.

According to Thailand State Quarantine and Travel Restrictions, students who have traveled from abroad to Thailand must pass a 14-day state quarantine period. Therefore, if students would like to take the SAT Test on **September 25, 2021** at Bangkok Christian International School SAT Test Center, they must have arrived in Thailand before midnight of **September 10, 2020** and be certified by a doctor with two negative Covid test results. And also, if students would like to take the SAT Test on **October 2, 2021**, they must have arrived in Thailand before midnight of **September 17, 2021** and be certified by a doctor with two negative Covid test results.

Students from abroad who pass the Thailand State Quarantine and Travel Restrictions will receive a doctor's certificate; they must present both their passport and this doctor's certificate to our administration staff at the registration point of the Test Center.

Due to COVID-19 Restrictions, the Test Center will require students to wear their face masks at all times, and all students need to maintain social distancing at all times during the test administration period. Alcohol gel will be provided in all rooms. The Royal Thai Government has designated COVID-19 a dangerous communicable disease under the Communicable Diseases Act 2015 (B.E.2558). Please be aware that if you come to the attention of Thai health authorities with a fever and flu-like symptoms, and have traveled internationally or had close contact with a known COVID-19 case within the past 14 days, you will be placed in isolation and required to undergo testing which can take up to 48 hours. If you are found to be positive, you will be hospitalized until symptoms resolve and you have two negative tests separated by 24 hours.
